A correspondent of the Pittsburg Mercury given the following account of an act unparalleled barbarity recently committed in that city.

"On Wednesday last, about noon a monster in human form proceeded from the stable of Rody Patterson into the adjoining yard of Mr. Sandal, chandler, on 4th street, leading a ferocious bull dog by a chain, and with true savage fury, let loose the enraged animal on a child. The writers of this article were eye witnesses, and implored the wretch to save the child's life who appeared to be in the jaws of death and nearly expiring by the bites and wounds inflicted. The lawless murderer aided by others appeared to delight in the tortures of the infant. The child it is understood is at the point of death."
