It Is Awful! A Little Daughter of Geo. Westfield Bitten by Vicious Dog and May Die

This morning, a Cedar Creek township farmer, whose name is not learned, drove to the city with a load of oats. A huge bull dog ran behind the wagon and while passing the residence of Mr. Geo. Westfield, of St. Joe township, the brut attacked Mr. Westfield's thirteen-year-old daughter and bit her in a frightful manner before he could be driven off. The child's flesh was out and scarred in an appalling matter, and it is doubtful if she survives.

The dog was killed by a posse of farmers.
